Description

Hexarelin stimulates GH secretion. Hexarelin is more resistant to proteolytic degradation than GHRP-6. Hexarelin has 7 amino acids H-His-D-2-Methyl-Trp-Ala-Trp-D-Phe-Lys-NH₂ and having a molecular weight of 887 Dalton. The Molecular Formula is C₄₇H₅₈N₁₂O₆.

Physical Appearance

Sterile Filtered lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder.

Purity

Greater than 98.0% as determined by:
(a) Analysis by RP-HPLC.
(b) Analysis by SDS-PAGE.

Formulation

The Hexarelin peptide was lyophilized with no additives.

Stability

Lyophilized Hexarelin although stable at room temperature for 3 weeks, should be stored desiccated below -18°C. Upon reconstitution Hexarelin should be stored at 4°C between 2-7 days and for future use below -18°C. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA).

Please prevent freeze-thaw cycles.
